Government of India has donated Rand two million (ZAR 2 million) to Ahmed Kathrada Foundation in South Africa. The decision to donate Rand 2 million was taken following the meeting between Prime Minister of India H.E. Mr. Narendra Modi and Mr. Ahmed Kathrada, a struggle hero of South Africa during the Prime Minister's visit to South Africa in July 2016.

High Commissioner H.E. Ruchi Ghanashyam informed the Foundation of the Government of India's approval to donate Rand 2 million to Ahmed Kathrada Foundation at an event to celebrate Mr. Ahmed Kathrada's birthday organised by Ahmed Kathrada Foundation in September 2016.
